## USGA Rules Govern All Play

except for the following local rules:

- Out of bounds defined by white stakes or lines. (USGA Rule 18.1)
- Yellow and red stakes or lines define penalty areas. (USGA Rule 17.1)
- Embedded ball rule is in effect through the general area. (USGA Rule 16.3)
- All artificially surfaced roads and paths are obstructions. (USGA Rule 16.1)
- All areas marked with white stakes with green tops are environmentally sensitive and play from these areas is prohibited. (USGA Rule 2.4)

### Care of the Course

- Please Repair your ball marks, Replace your divots and Rake our bunkers.
- Hole locations are indicated by flag color: Blue=Back, White=Middle, Red=Front.
- Please keep both electric and pull carts 30 feet from our greens.
- All play is from tee markers only.
- Please follow all posted cart signs.

### Pace of Play:

HSR recognizes nothing detracts from the enjoyment of the game more than slow play. On-course Rangers, and course management, have final determination of pace of play performance. You are required to play 18 holes in 4 Hours or less. Please play ready golf and keep pace with the group in front of you. Failure to maintain proper pace of play may result in forward movement on the course, or removal entirely.
